**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
VIRGINIA NONSTOCK CORPORATION**

The undersigned, pursuant to Chapter 10 of Title 13.1 of the Code of Virginia, state(s) as follows:

1. The name of the corporation is Our Task, Inc.
2. The corporation is to have the following class of members: No members.
3. The affairs of the corporation shall be regulated by its Board of Trustees. The members of the Board of Trustees shall be those individuals elected, from time to time, by majority vote of the Board of Trustees present. The Board of Trustees may adopt By-Laws.
4. The name of the corporation's initial registered agent is Gerald O. Barney, who is a resident of Virginia and also an initial Trustee of the corporation.
5. The corporation's initial registered office address, including the street and number, if any, which is identical to the business office of the initial registered agent, is 1900 North Harvard Street, Arlington, VA, 22201. The registered office is physically located in the county of Arlington, Virginia.
6. The corporation, which is perpetual in duration, is organized exclusively for charitable purposes as defined in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax law. In pursuit of these purposes the corporation may:
  - a. Conduct research and analysis on issues relating to (a) the cultural institutions and activities needed to create and sustain a mutually enhancing relationship between humans and Earth, (b) the factors that influence or limit the opportunities for a healthy and fulfilling life for young persons and their descendents.
  - b. Employ on modern methods of analysis including but not limited to modeling and simulation using computers, use of computer simulation models, geographic information systems, statistical data analysis, public opinion polling, technology assessment, and environmental assessment to analyze economic, social, and environmental issues likely to be of concern to by young persons and their descendents.
  - c. Disseminate the results of such research and analyses to the general public and leaders of culture-shaping and -guiding institutions using all means of communication including, but not limited to conferences, Web pages, e-mail, newsletters, publications, speeches, press releases, voter education, and other means of communication.
  - d. Organize conferences and meetings of adults and young people in the United States or elsewhere in the world of young people and/or leaders of organizations that shape the evolution of culture, including, but not limited to: religion and spirituality, government, international organizations, business and labor, communications media, science and technology, education, and civil society.
  - e. Develop collaborative programs with such organizations on environmental sustainability issues, alternative courses of action, and educational and vocational opportunities for young persons.
  - f. Support the efforts of young people to advocate effectively for the sustainable future their generation needs.
  - g. Engage volunteers to support the whole program of Our Task, Inc.

- h. Make distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax law.
- i. Do all things necessary and proper to accomplish its general charitable purposes.

7. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and expenses incurred and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in article 6 hereof.

8. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or interfere in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

9. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activity or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

10. Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax law or shall be distributed to the federal government or to a state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
